When coal, oil and gas are burned, a gas called **helium/carbon dioxide** is released into the air.

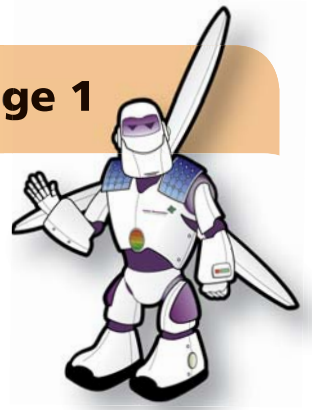
Today, people are burning **more/less** fuels like coal, oil and gas.
